SLT Meeting Monday October 18th, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 8:09 by Sr. Sinchi.

Minutes from the September 20th, 2021 meeting were called for approval. Mr. Daub motioned to approve the minutes, Ashanti Ramirez offered a second.

- SEL ice breaker question: What was a highlight from your weekend?
- Old Business: a) Update on vacancies (parent and 12th grade student rep) b) decision on posting notes online: Julia Cantor, a twelfth grade student will be present starting at the November SLT meeting. At tomorrow's PA elections, there will be further discussion on the new parent representatives. Sr. Sinchi will post the September notes.
- BIG THANK YOU TO PA for providing pizza at the freshman mixer, BIG SUCCESS: Freshmen students vocalized their excitement about the event and at the end of the mixer, students began giving shout-outs to one another. There will be an estimate of three mixers per grade during the 2021-2022 school year.

New Business:

- **Principal's Report (Dr. Froner):** Dr. Froner reflects that the daily SEL practices are going well. He gave a shout out to Tamar who began providing alternative check-in questions to teachers before first period via the loudspeaker. Dr. Froner states that his instructional vision for this year is to provide SEL practices as a resource for stress management.
- Inquiry about skateboard lockers for students (Sinchi, Farulla, 11th grade student): Dr. Froner wonders if the PA can fund a skateboard locker for students by the bike rack. Ms. Byala will bring the offer to the PA. Dr. Froner proposes that MHSHS offers to purchase the skate rack for the MLK campus. Ms. Farulla estimates that 8-10 students have asked for the skateboard locker as of this year. In addition, she adds that it is a form of self regulation for students with IEPs and could have many benefits for our school.
- **9th grade representative?:** Tamar expresses that student council elections will occur mid-November. Following elections, the teachers will select the SLT representative from the grade representatives. The SLT discusses having two representatives per grade instead of one.
- What is the school budget looking like? (SLT View) Enrollment? What are we expecting as we approach the October 31st deadline? Dr. Froner received the report over the weekend: The mid-year adjustment will be released on October 31st and MHSHS is anticipating a \$60,000 adjustment. For the 2021-2022 admissions cycle we will need to follow up with enrollment regarding the Discovery Program admissions dates.
